Toscana Rosso Indicazione Geografica Tipica



A harmonious balance between two outstanding grapes, Merlot and Petit Verdot. That, put very simply, is the calling card of Lodano Rosso, a wine that is intense yet highly appealing and easy to drink: a way to discover the unique terroir of Tua Rita.



Area of production: Upper Maremma, Colline Metallifere zone

Designation: IGT – Indicazione Geografica Tipica – Toscana Rosso

First vintage: 2017

Varieties: 60% Petit Verdot, 40% Merlot

Vineyards age: Petit Verdot 8 years, Merlot 35 years

Training system: guyot

Soil: Markedly clayey with a fairly significant pebble fraction. The higher plots are more pebbly, those lower down have more silt. Mid slope, where Merlot is grown, there is a higher fraction of clay

Vineyard management: integrated pest management

Alcohol content: 14,5

Harvesting method: manually in 15-kg cases

Maturation: for about 18 months in new and one-used French oak barriques and american oak barrels

Serving temperature: 15-18 °C

Formats: 75-cl bottles in 6-unit cartons and wooden cases
